Headteacher/Chair of Governors must report all allegations against staff and volunteers to the LADO (Local Authority Designated Officer).

### **Initial Action**

- The person who has received an allegation or witnessed an event will immediately inform the headteacher and make a record.
- In the event that an allegation is made against the headteacher the matter will be reported to the Chair of Governors and CEO who will proceed as the 'headteacher'.
- The headteacher will take steps, where necessary, to secure the immediate safety of children and any urgent medical needs.
- The member of staff will not be approached at this stage unless it is necessary to address the **immediate** safety of children.
- The headteacher may need to clarify any information regarding the allegation, however no person will be formally interviewed or asked to give a formal statement at this stage.
- The headteacher will consult with Education LADO (see below) in order to determine if it
  is appropriate for the allegation to be dealt with by school or if there needs to be a
  meeting with social care and/or the police to consider if they should undertake an
  investigation.
- Consideration will be given throughout to the support and information needs of pupils, parents and staff.
- The Headteacher will inform the Chair of Governors of any allegation.
- The Headteacher will inform the CEO of any allegation.
